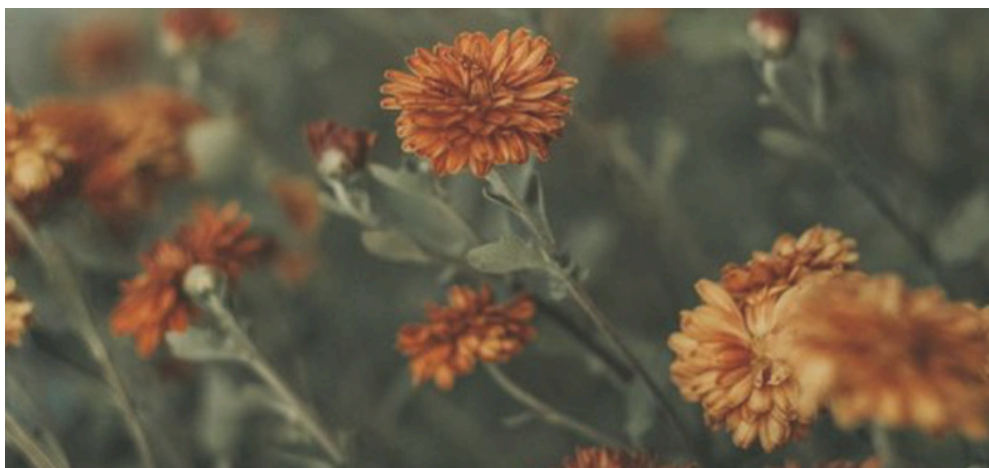

Heart to Table Warm, Mug Apple Crisp

1 small chopped apple

1 tsp butter

1 tsp maple syrup

2 tbsp oats

1 tbsp flour (or almond flour)

dash of cinnamon

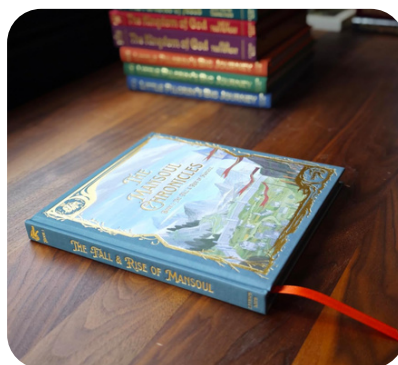
Praying the Bible - Donald S. Whitney
