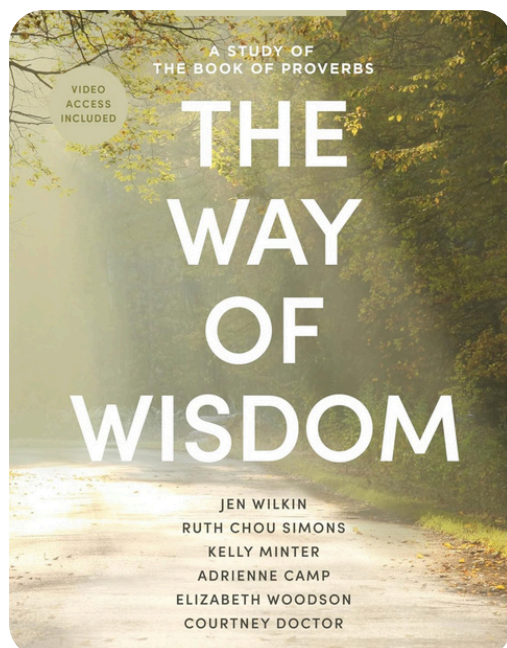

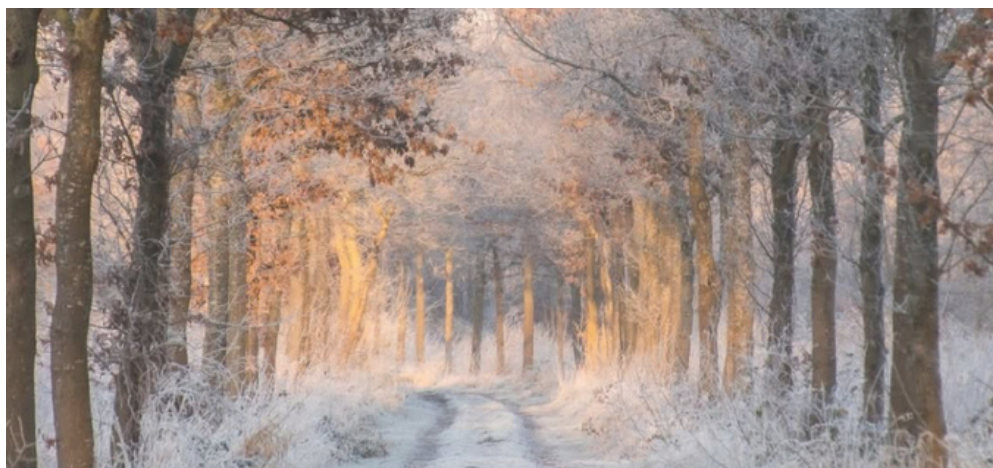

Heart to Table Homemade Hot Cocoa

2 cups of milk

1 tbsp cocoa powder

1 tbsp brown sugar or maple syrup

½ cup semi-sweet chocolate

1 tsp vanilla

1. In a medium sauce pan, combine cocoa powder, sugar & vanilla
2. Gradually add the milk while whisking to combine. Place over medium heat
3. Heat stirring occasionally until gently boiled
4. Add chocolate pieces once starting to boil, stir until creamy
5. Pour into mugs and enjoy!

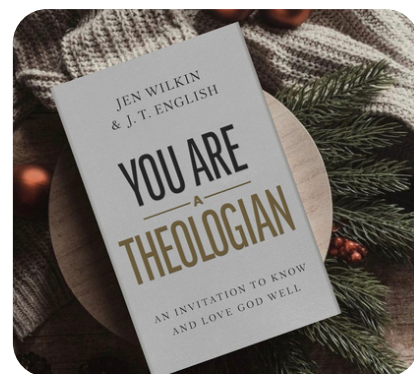

With carefully crafted intention, this beautiful volume of 32 seasonal devotions encourages readers in any circumstance to become deeply rooted in God's faithful promises.



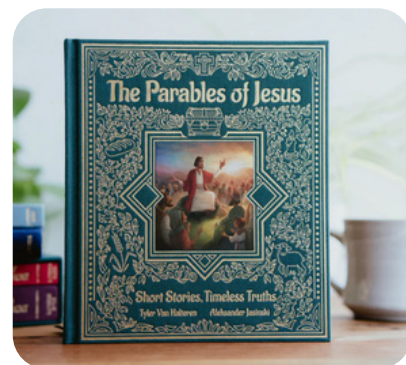
You Are a Theologian - Jen Wilkin & J.T. English
